Most parade elements will assemble at

Panther Island Pavilion

Parade participants should arrive at Panther Island no later than 9:30 a.m., Wednesday, Nov. 11, 2020. The Pavilion area will be open for check-in beginning at 8 a.m. All floats and vehicles must be in place by 10 a.m. The Fort Worth Police Dept. will begin shutting down access streets at 9:30 a.m.

Sign In

All parade participants must sign in with a Tarrant County Veterans Council representative at Stage 4 located in the center of the parking lot. **Follow the signs.**

At sign-in, you'll be directed to a specific line up or parking area for your entry or vehicle. Participants & guests may park at this location until after the parade.

Cadets & Bands

JROTC and Cadet Corps units have designated assembly areas on Panther Island and coordinators will provide oversight. High school bands will assemble on the lawn east of the Tarrant County Courthouse.

Street Closures

To ensure safety and security throughout the Tarrant County Veterans Day Parade. The FWPD will shut down streets crossing the parade route through downtown Fort Worth. The 200 block of N. Taylor Street (from Belknap to the parking circle) will be closed to vehicle traffic or parking from 9:30 a.m. until 1 p.m. Bicycle and foot traffic in the area is allowed and bicycle rentals will be open.

The following streets will be closed by 10 a.m. and will reopen following the parade (shortly after noon):
